

Studies on the Planning and Administration of  
Recreation Activity

- From Practical Guidance to the Juvenile Jamboree in Aso  
District

The recreation activity of "Aso Juvenile Jamboree" was planned and practically guided. Results obtained were following.

- 1) Eighty-five percent of children who took part in were satisfied with contents of the planning in summer and winter, 1978 and in summer, 1979. They understood the significance of participation.
- 2) Programs varied with each plan and those favorite for children were "Kimodameshi" and telling ghost stories, and followed by adventure climbing, campfire, light sport, Randmaking, swimming cooking outdoors and so forth.
- 3) Sternness, friendship and enjoyment were aimed for guide every time and children acted well on them.
- 4) The activity was succeeded in by favorable environment in Aso and contexts of programs, regardless of short periods over four nights.
